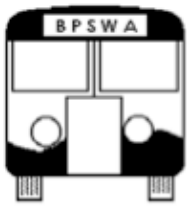

Bus Preservation Society of WA has no paid employees and is operated and managed by its Members on a volunteer basis. The Management Council (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and five Councillors) manage the day to day affairs of the Society. It establishes strategic direction and plans, manages the legal and regulatory responsibilities and maintains financial stability.

The Bus Collection and extensive Archives and Memorabilia Collection are kept in our Depot at Whiteman Park. The Depot includes a workshop where our buses are garaged, serviced, repaired and restored for display and operational service.

BPSWA publishes a quarterly magazine “Rattler” for its members. It contains articles and photographs of current and historic bus interest and is included as a benefit of membership of the Society.

BPSWA maintains a website (BPSWA.org) through which the membership and the public can be informed, maintain communication and are encouraged to participate in the life of the Society.

BPSWA maintains a calendar of Events that includes Historic Bus related anniversaries and celebrations, entertainment and social functions.
